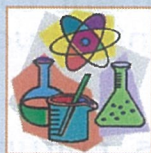

Statement of Philosophy

for their vision, their delight in children, their skill, dedication, knowledge and commitment to families.

We value families . . .

for their bonds and traditions, their commitment to career, home and community, and their visions for their children's education.

We value Judaism . . .

for the spirit of its teachings, values, traditions, culture and heritage. We encourage families to embrace Judaism at their own comfort level.

Parent and teacher partnerships are fundamental to the foundation of our camp community. This reciprocal relationship is built on mutual respect, cooperation, and shared responsibility. Our collaboration enables an effective communication network that enriches the growth, care and development of each child.

Our camp provides a warm, nurturing and child-centered environment in which children can make friends, be active in the fresh air, and enjoy the summer under the supervision of caring adults.

Our groups are small so that we can provide appropriate attention to each child. Our professional staff is selected for their educational background, early childhood training, teaching experience, and for their sensitivity to the individual needs of the young child.
