THE KOSLOWE GALLERY PRESENTS "MAYIM CHAIYIM: A WATERSHED"

Stay tuned for our virtual tour of the exhibition and the show's installation gallery this month. The show explores the watery underpinnings of Judaism and how those teachings can be a guide. Each artist has been exploring different aspects of modern neglect on our waterways and each piece suggests the centrality of awareness, Tikkun Olam (repair), and renewal. Whether it is glaciers breaking apart (Tobi Kahn) or vessels as metaphors for what is full and empty (Robin Atlas), the art reflects these considerations. The simple act of hand-washing and mikveh, which wash away our trials and ready us for the sanctity of Shabbat (Susan Miller) reminds us of water's role in our renewal. Learn more at wjcenter.org.

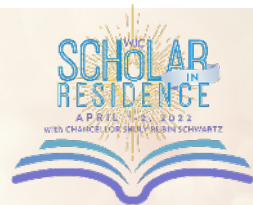

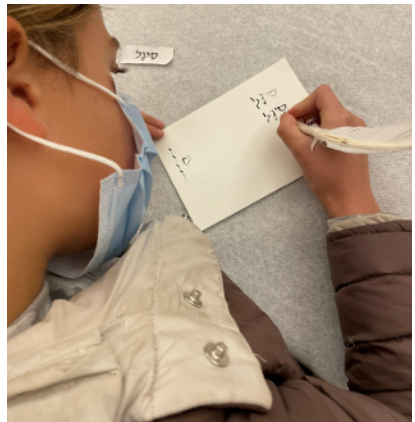


COOKING WITH ECC
