Students in the ECC prepared for Sukkot by painting mini pumpkins, which they hung in the Sukkah.



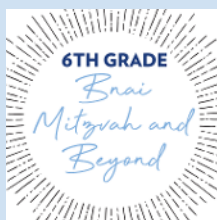
▲ SOUND THE SHOFAR

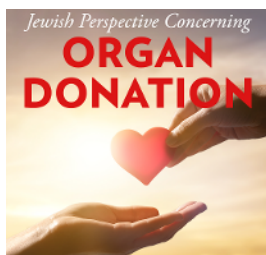
